Alumni Council Membership Requirements

A member of the Alumni Council (AC) should be selected to hold the position based on demonstrated involvement, support and commitment to Appalachian. The individual should agree to fulfill the responsibilities associated with Council membership, including but not limited to:

- a. Attending and participating in a least three of the four scheduled Council meetings/Homecoming each year. Members who miss two consecutive Council meetings/Homecoming except for extenuating circumstances (i.e.: family, health, work or prior commitments) will be asked to resign.
- b. Serving actively on Council committees and task forces as assigned.
- c. Becoming a representative and spokesperson in your community for ASU. This could involve talking with prospective students, meeting with local alumni, communicating with area elected officials, attending local alumni events, and more.
- d. Seeking out and encouraging talented alumni for membership on the Council, participate in local alumni activities and to nominate outstanding alumni for awards.
- e. Assisting the University and the Alumni Association in identifying, cultivating, and involving alumni in areas such as student recruitment, job placement, legislative advocacy and financial support.
- f. Assisting the University and the Alumni Association office in identifying and implementing programs that will enhance the student experience at ASU, thus helping mold more loyal alumni.
- g. Being familiar with the programs and activities sponsored, organized, and coordinated by the Alumni Association and participating in them to the extent possible, including major campus events.
- h. Contributing financially to ASU each year.
- i. Offering ideas to help make the Council and Alumni Association more meaningful to the alumni constituency and initiating Council activities and initiatives.
- j. Being an ambassador, spokesperson and advocate of the Alumni Association and Appalachian State University.
